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## Version 1: With band's own FOH engineer

### **Lineup and Equipment**

#### The band bring their own:

- mixer
- microphones
- mic stands
- cables
- in-ear monitors
- stage box

#### The venue needs to provide:

#### PA system

A sufficient well-functioning PA system should be available at the venue. The band's stage box shall be connected to the PA system (via stereo XLR) on stage

#### Monitors, at least 2

2–3 floor monitors should be placed in front for singer Marco and guitarist Jim (these can be grouped in mono). Drummer Simon prefers in-ear monitoring, so a third one by the drums is ok, but not necessary

A sufficient well-functioning PA system + mixer should be available at the venue


