Lineup and Equipment

The band bring their own:

- mixer
- microphones
- mic stands
- cables
- in-ear monitors
- stage box

The venue needs to provide:

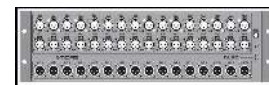
- **PA system**
A sufficient well-functioning PA system should be available at the venue. The band's stage box shall be connected to the PA system (via stereo XLR) on stage
- **Monitors, at least 2**
2–3 floor monitors should be placed in front for singer Marco and guitarist Jim (these can be grouped in mono). Drummer Simon prefers in-ear monitoring, so a third one by the drums is ok, but not necessary

- **Beer is always very much appreciated (also a couple of alcohol-free bottles)**

Version 2: Without band's own FOH engineer

Lineup and Equipment

The band bring their own instruments, amps and cables.

The venue needs to provide:

- **FOH engineer**
The band shall be provided with contact information to the engineer ASAP when the show is confirmed
- **PA system**
A sufficient well-functioning PA system + mixer should be available at the venue
- **Microphones x 3**
- **Mic stands x 3**
- **Monitors x 3**

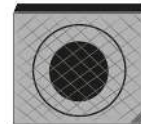
